University of Wisconsin--Green Bay

- July, 2020--Dates to be announced soon!
- 8:30 a.m. to 3:40 p.m.
- For students entering grades 9-12 for the 2020-2021 school year
- Commuter cost \$365
 - Leave camp at 3:40 each day and return the next morning for 8:30
 - Includes instruction, lunches, and a camp t-shirt
- Resident cost \$595 (plus \$30-40 for evening activities and snacks)
 - Stay in the residence halls overnite for the week of camp
 - Includes instruction, room/board, counselor supervision, evening activity transportation, and a camp t-shirt
- Scholarships available through UWGB, financial need based; criteria and application can be found online
- Placement auditions will be done for all students. Auditions are for placement only and not for admittance into camp.
- Two elective classes (the earlier you register for camp, the more options you have)
- Concert at 6 p.m. on the Friday of camp week.

Rock Academy was created to inspire the full band experience. Campers will work directly with some of the top performers, music educators and Grammy-nominated artists in the business today. You will establish key skills necessary to becoming not just a better player, but developing a more in-depth understanding of what it takes to be a performer, songwriter and improviser. In addition to putting together a rock concert at the end of the week, each student will work with faculty to write and arrange two to three songs to perform at the final concert. - For students entering grades 9-12
- Commuter cost \$445 (2019 cost; 2020 cost to be announced)
 - Includes instruction, noon and evening meals, camp t-shirt, and insurance
- Resident cost \$495 (2019 cost; 2020 cost to be announced)
 - Includes lodging, instruction, meals, camp t-shirt, insurance
- \$20 discount per person if at least 8 students from the same school attend
- Several scholarships awarded at the final concert for the next summer's camp.
- Elective classes available
- Auditions for placement in appropriate band

- For students entering grades 9-12 and graduating seniors
- Commuter cost \$475 early bird; \$500 after early bird deadline (2019 cost)
 - Includes classes, materials, and lunch
- Resident cost \$625 early bird; \$650 after early bird deadline (2019 cost)
 - Includes classes, materials, all meals and lodging
- Scholarships through UWSP are available.
- Concert on Friday during the week of camp.
- All instructors are UWSP faculty or artists
- Instruction for a minimum of 4 hours per day on your major instrument with option for more musical activities.
- Optional composition program.
